All the candidate who are contesting college Students Union Election 2024 are required to attend Campus Candidate Debate related to College Election 2024 on 23rd September, 2024 at 5:00 pm. at open Auditorium near Gate No. 1 of the College.

Following are the rules of behaviour for during the Campus Candidate Debate.

- 1. **Time Limit:** Each candidate will be strictly limited to **7 minutes** for their presentation/speech. A warning bell at the 8th minute will ring. The candidate is then expected to conclude his/her speech in the next two minutes.
- 2. Content: Candidates must focus their presentations on their agenda for the student union. Personal attacks, insults, bullying rival candidates or use of any unparliamentary words will not be tolerated. In such cases the moderation team is authorised to ask the candidate to end his/her speech at once and leave the dias.
- 3. All statements made must be relevant to the candidate's agenda and the overall purpose of the debate.
- 4. Candidates are encouraged to support their claims with evidence, facts, or examples.
- 5. Candidates must maintain respectful and courteous behaviour throughout the debate. Any form of harassment, intimidation will not be tolerated.
- Question and Answer Session: Candidates are expected to answer the three questions chosen by the lucky draw in a clear, concise, and informative manner.
- 7. **Time Limit for Answers:** Candidates will have a time limit of a total of **3 minutes** to answer all three questions.
- 8. The audience must maintain complete silence during the speeches and question and answer session.
- 9. The audience must respect the speakers and their viewpoints. The Audience is expected to refrain from indulging in any unnecessary sloganeering, booing and raising of any uncivil slogans.

- 10. Question Submission by audience: Audience members can submit questions to the student volunteers during the speeches. Don't forget to mention the name and post of the Candidate to whom you are addressing the question to.
- 11. Questions should be relevant to the candidates' agendas and avoid personal attacks or insults.
